## 100% Estate Carignan Homestead Hill Vineyard - Willow Creek District Paso Robles 142 cases, bottled April 2022

An intoxicating nose of baking spices, lavender, tobacco, and a mix of candy-like red fruits. Darker and more intense fruits then lead to a palate of savory cinnamon, ripe cranberry, and chalky minerality. Moderate, sandy tannins and refreshing acidity provide for a lengthy and memorable finish. Carignon pairs exceptionally with a giant charcuterie board of cured meats and aged cheeses, you could also have it for company and some homemade summer ratatouille. Cellar through 2032.

## 2022 CINSAULT

## 100% Cinsault Glenrose Vineyard - Adelaida District Paso Robles 278 cases, bottled August 2023

Baked raspberry tart on the nose with underlying herbal notes of black tea and a touch of suede float from the glass and invite a deeper inspection, revealing characteristics of bright strawberry, dried orange peel, or a hike through a eucalyptus grove at Montaña de Oro. Through this bottle in the fridge for 15 minutes, get the pizza oven fired up and invite some friends over. Cellar through 2028.



### 2022 CONTROLLED CHAOS

50% Mourvèdre, 17% Grenache, 17% Counoise, 16% Zinfandel Paso Robles

#### 186 cases, bottled August 2022

With aromas of Rainier cherries and cranberries, this wine is bursting with boysenberry, raspberry, and red plum fruits and a subtle damp earthiness. The bright acidity and chewy tannins contribute to a lengthy and balanced finish. This wine's perfect pairing is a rich, creamy mushroom risotto. Cellar through 2034.

Maraschino cherries, red plum, and a touch of black pepper entice you on the nose. The impressive palate combines red and black fruits with a dusting of cinnamon and clove. This wine would be excellent a homemade marinana, spaghetti and meatballs. Cellar through 2032.

## 100% Estate Svrah Homestead Hill Vineyard - Willow Creek District Paso Robles 294 cases. bottled February 2023

On the nose of this bottling, blueberry jam, and asphalt aromas hint at fennel at times. Balanced tannins introduce the palate, opening into dark fruits like black and blueberry, accompanied by violets, pepper, and a hint of baking chocolate. Open this vintage and enjoy with buffalo wings, chili and ribs. Cellar through 2029.

### 2021 HOMESTEAD HILL ZINFANDEL

## 100% Estate Zinfandel Homestead Hill Vineyard -Willow Creek District Paso Robles 200 cases, bottled August 2023

This Zinfandel boasts a bouquet of dusty red fruit, marzipan and baked cherry pie. The palate is broad with fresh cherries, ripe plum reduction with an earthy backbone. Classic zin pepper notes come through on the finish of this elegant wine. Pair this on any night with barbeque potato chips and a roast beef sandwich. Cellar through 2030.







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
